

Regulations on Trimo Architectural Awards 2009 for Most Creative Performed Solutions, using Trimo Products

Article 1

Trimo d.d., Prijateljjeva cesta 12, 8210 Trebnje (in continuation: the company) defines with this Regulations document, the awards presented by the company, to architects and designers (in continuation: the candidate), the terms and the procedure of its awarding.

Article 2

Purpose of the award is to encourage the use of Trimo products in modern architecture. Solutions, assured by Trimo products, should distinguish themselves by their design and round up the entirety. They should present design advantages and economical use in modern architecture. They should also raise the profile of Trimo products with the public.

Article 3

Company has for this purpose a prize fund in sum of 45.000 €.

Article 4

The sum of 45.000 € will be shared among prize-winners on the basis of the award's committee's decision.

Article 5

The company commits itself to sharing all of the awards in where multiple quality solutions are received. The company reserves the right to distribute the prize fund differently if the award's committee decides that all the registered works do not suit quality criteria for award awarding.

Article 6

The awards are open to solutions that have been already realized for a concrete object, during the last 3 (three) years, but not later than by 1st March 2009. The location of the object may be in Slovenia or in any other country.

Article 7

A candidate may submit multiple solutions. Each solution counts as an individual entry.

Article 8

The candidates can apply to enter the award using the competition criteria published on the web page of the company www.trimo.si and on the announcement of the competition in Informa nr. 17.

Article 9

The competition is open to candidates with permanent residence in Slovenia or in any other foreign country.

Article 10

An entry may be submitted by a third person, with the written consent of the candidate.

Article 11

The completed entry form is considered an entry. No later than 10th April 2009 a candidate should submit a company argumentation; this should introduce the solution (up to 1000 signs) in English and be accompanied by three different photos, A4 format, or in digital form (A4 format, resolution 300 dpi), showing the performed solution. In the instance where a candidate has been submitted by a third person, the written candidate's consent should also be attached.

Article 12

Entries together with required material should be sent by registered post to: Trimo d.d., Prijateljjeva cesta 12, 8210 Trebnje, Slovenia. Sealed envelopes should be clearly marked, "Trimo Architectural Awards 2009".

The entry may also be completed at www.trimo.si and required material may be submitted by e-mail: award@trimo.si.

Article 13

Candidates, who are proclaimed as prize-winners by the award's committee, should introduce their rewarded solution on their exhibition stand. The marketing department of Trimo prepares the exhibition stands. Prize-winners should, by 15th May 2009, submit the necessary data and material for the preparation of exhibition stand.

Article 14

An exhibition stand has to include:

- photos of the object,
- data on the object - title, location, year of performance,
- data on the candidate.

Article 15

The entry may be used by the company in media and for other promotional purposes.

Article 16

The election procedure of solutions for awarding the award is lead by the award's committee, which is appointed by collegiate body of the company.

Article 17

The assignments of award's committee are:

- to lead the procedure of receiving and judging the entries,
- to prepare an explanation proposal for the award which determines the prize giving.

Article 18

The award's committee shall, not later than in 30 days since the date defined to submit the entry until 11th May 2009, inform the prize-winners of winning the award. Prize-winners will be informed of the award's committee decision before public announcement.

Article 19

Solutions will be publicly introduced and the prize-winners will be publicly announced at the prize-giving ceremony. Precise date and place of the ceremony will be published after the 11th May 2009.

Article 20

Decision of the award's committee is final.

Article 21

Value-added tax is included in the value of the award. A prize-winner has to pay the company before receiving the award a deposit of income tax at the rate of 25 % on personal receivings. They can do so on the company's cash desk or with the money order on the current account of the company. Prize-winner is obliged to provide the required data to the company before accepting the award.

Article 22

All the changes and completions of the regulations are adopted in a way and in procedure under which this Regulations document was accepted.

Article 23

Regulations document enters into force one day after the acceptance at the collegiate body's meeting of the company.
